



# 2025 - 2026 MENTEE EXPECTATIONS

## Who is eligible to be a Mentee?

- Mentees may be undergrad students from any higher education institution that holds an active TCCP membership. (List of higher education institutions with active TCCP memberships can be found on TCCP's website.)
- In order to be eligible to participate in the Women In Tech Mentoring Program, undergrad students must be actively enrolled with a TCCP-member higher education institution.

### How are Mentees matched with Mentors?

• Ideally, Mentees will be matched with Mentors based on common career interests, regionality and / or graduation year although we recognize that this may not always be possible.

### What are the expectations and time commitment of a Mentee?

- Attend virtual WIT Mentor Program kick-off event on Thursday, 10/16/2025 from 6pm 7pm.
- Meet with Mentor at least once per month via phone, videoconference or in-person meeting.
- Participate in WIT Mentoring Group meetings at least once per month.
- Attend the in-person WIT Mentor Program wrap-up luncheon in April 2026 tentatively planned for Saturday, 4/4/2026, from 11am 1pm in the Harrisburg-area.
- Mentors will be available for Mentees as needed between formal meetings. Mentees will be encouraged to touch base with their Mentors on a regular basis between regularly scheduled meetings.

### How often do the WIT Mentoring Groups meet?

- WIT Mentoring Groups meet for 1 2 hours once a month, from October through April.
- WIT Mentoring Groups can meet virtually or in person this is up to each WIT Mentoring Group's preferences.

### How many Mentees are in each WIT Mentoring Group?

- Each WIT Mentoring Group will be comprised of 6 8 members (3 to 4 Mentees + 3 to 4 Mentors).
- Mentees assigned to each group will represent a variety of higher education institutions.
